Morling College including Vose Campus

This is a list of the units Morling College plans to offer in 2021, covering campuses in Sydney and Perth, in light of the impending merger of Morling College and Vose Seminary on January 1, 2021. In the unlikely event the merger does not proceed as planned, a revised list of unit offerings will be published by the respective colleges prior to that date (i.e. early November).

Guide to the unit delivery modes

For all of 2021, flexible delivery provisions due to COVID-19 will continue. Students intending to participate in face-to-face and/or livestreamed classes will enrol as **on campus** students; those intending to study via online materials and/or recorded video lectures will enrol as **online** students.

The unit schedule uses the following symbols for the different modes available:

Face-to-face options: If this mode is chosen, we ask for a commitment to attend at least 80% of on campus class hours to ensure a consistent group. Ideal for those who live near the campus and are available at the scheduled time.



Sydney: daytime class, face-to-face on our Sydney Campus in Macquarie Park, NSW.



Sydney: evening class, face-to-face on our Sydney Campus in Macquarie Park, NSW.



Perth: daytime class, face-to-face on our Perth (Vose) Campus in Bentley, WA.



Perth: evening class, face-to-face on our Perth (Vose) Campus in Bentley, WA.



Morling South: Tuesday evening class, face-to-face on our Southern Sydney campus at Padstow Baptist Church.

Other delivery modes:



Livestreamed video lectures. Lectures which are open to live, interactive attendance via the Zoom platform will display this icon. If this mode is chosen we ask for a commitment to attend 80% of livestream class hours to ensure a consistent student group. This is ideal for those who are unable to get to the campus but are available at the scheduled time and wish to interact with the lecturer and other students. **Check the face-to-face timetable for livestreamed lecture times;** currently it is *mostly* Sydney-based classes which will be livestreamed, but all livestream options are open to all students. Further, a small number of units will only be available as livestreamed lectures.



Recorded video/audio lectures (watching/listening to a recording of the lecture at a different time). This is a good option for those who are unavailable at the lecture time, but would still like to watch/listen to full lectures. Students are also encouraged to attend the online virtual classroom sessions. (Not all units will be available in this delivery mode due to the confidential nature of some of the content/discussion.)



Online materials (e.g. short videos, lecture notes, curated readings, discussion forums). Most online units also have several real-time, online virtual classroom sessions. This is a good option for those who are unavailable at the lecture time, and prefer materials specifically developed for self-directed online learning. Any RV lectures are also available to ONL students.














Semi-intensive: several half/full days of lectures spread over a semester (or full year for some units), most with an online component to be completed individually. The face-to-face component may be available via livestream if the livestream icon is displayed.














































Intensive: several consecutive full days of face-to-face lectures with an online component of between 20% and 60% to be completed individually. The face-to-face component may be available via livestream if the livestream icon is displayed.
